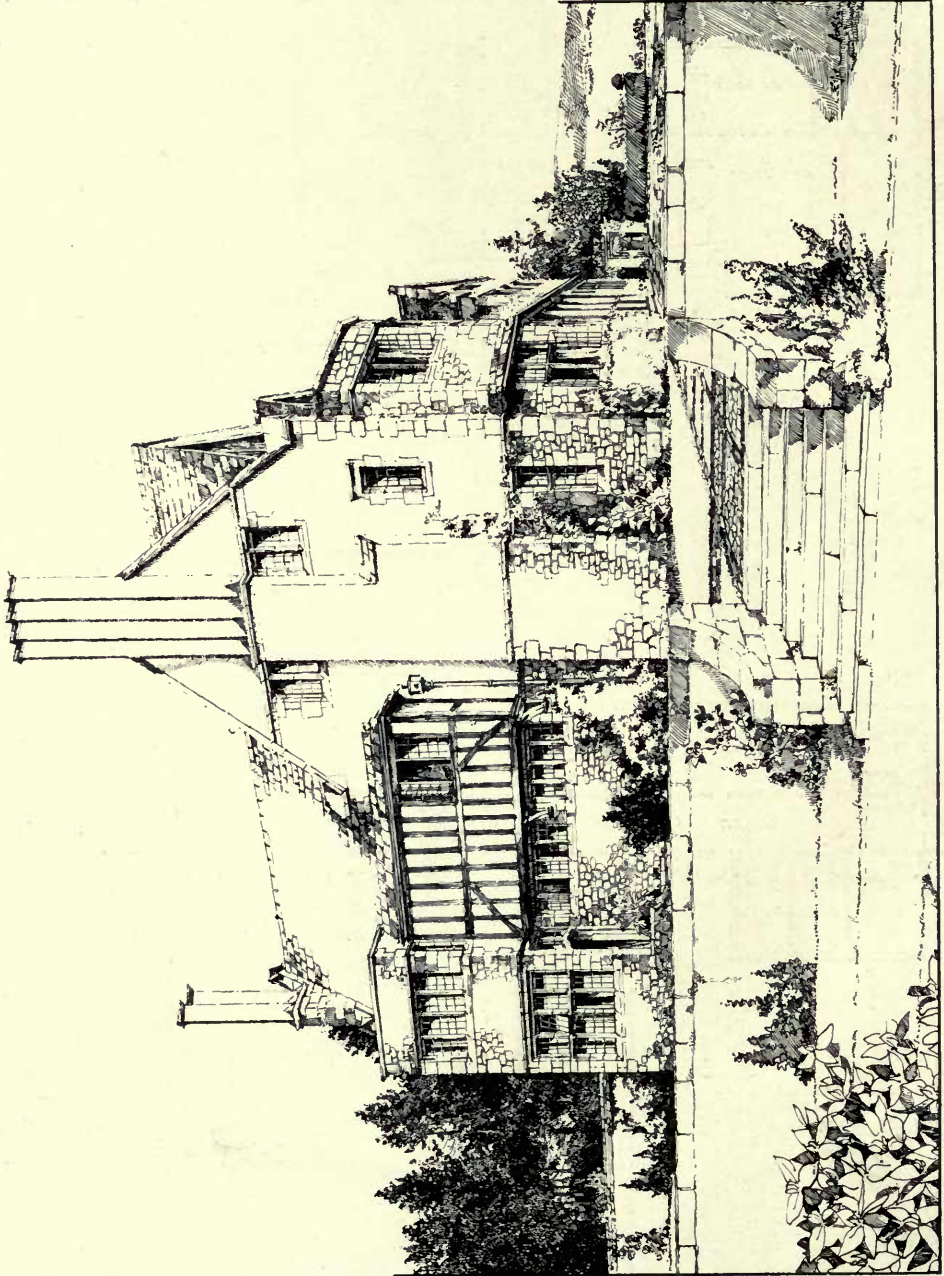


FIRST FLOOR PLAN.
