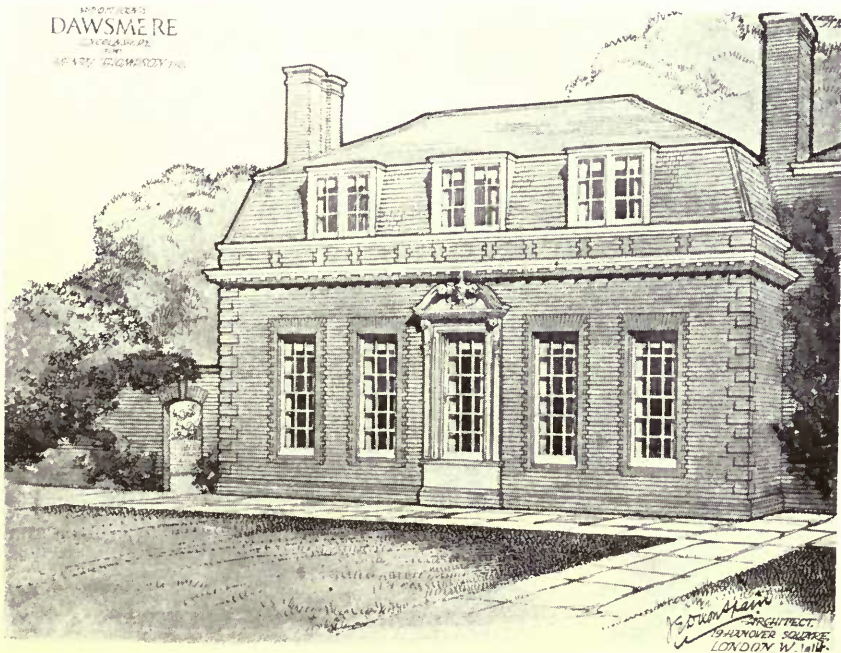


Symington Lodge, Lanarkshire : Ground Floor Plan.

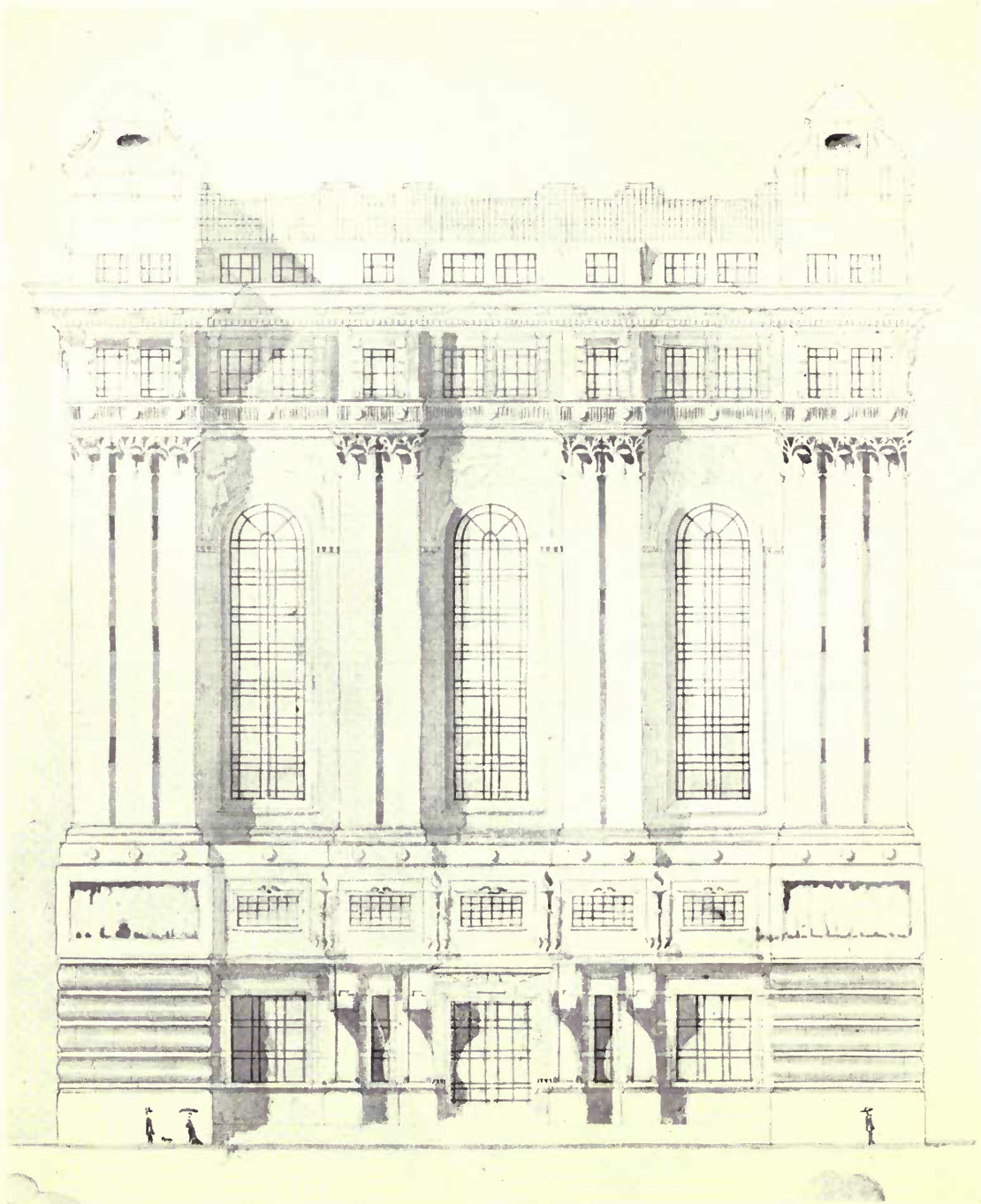
JARDINIA STREET GROUND FLOOR PLAN.

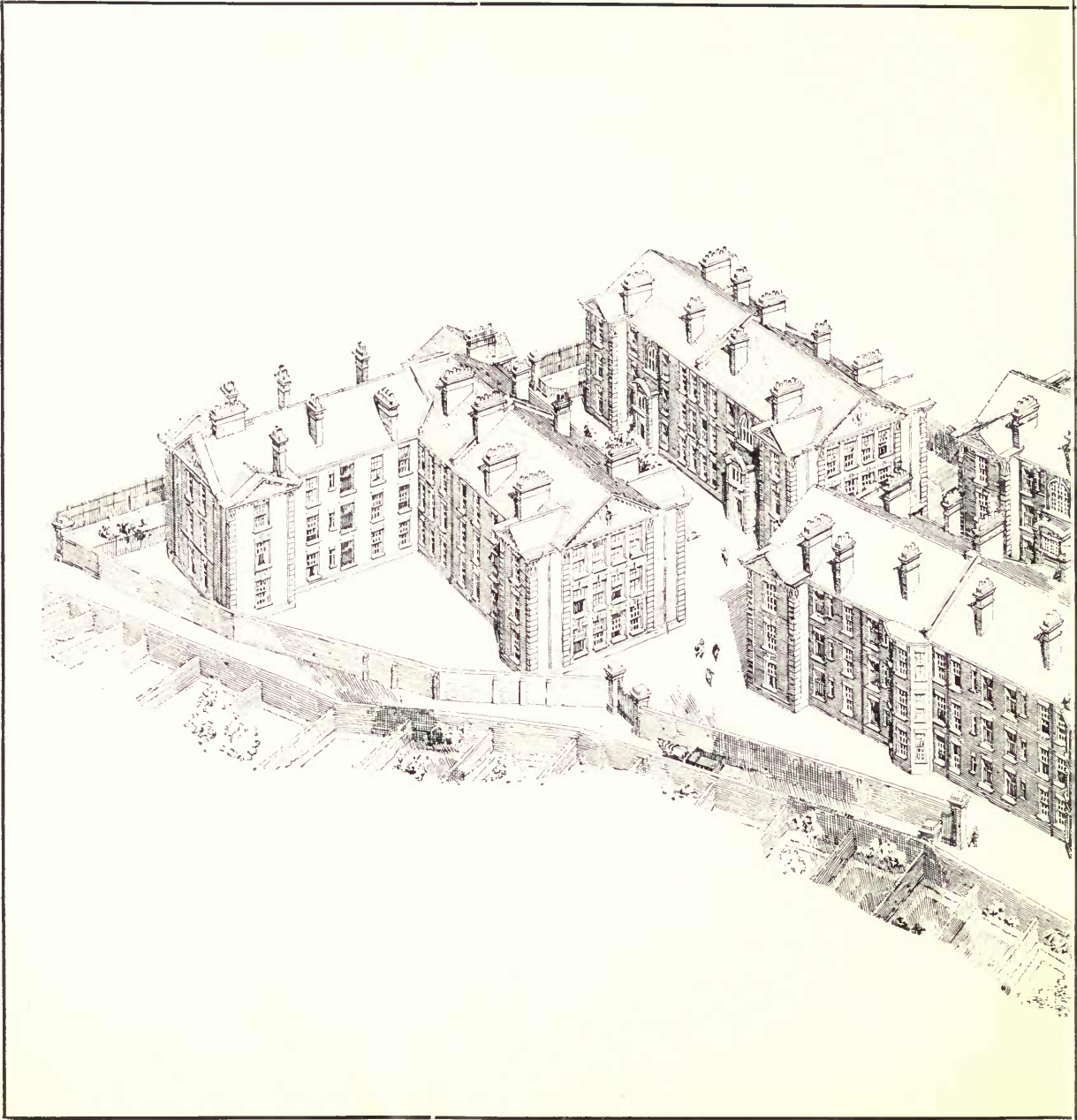

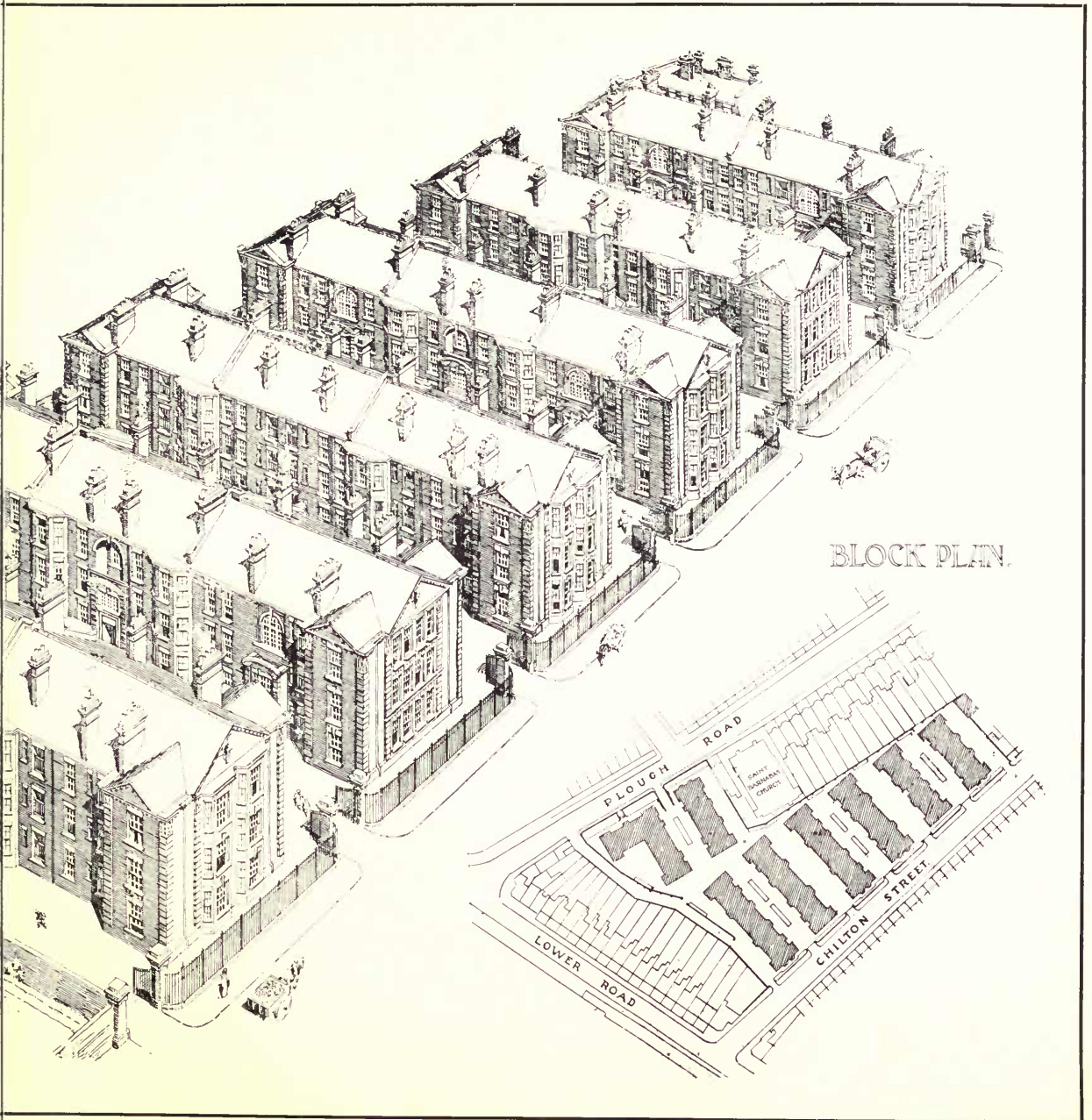


Design for an Aero Railway Station in a City.

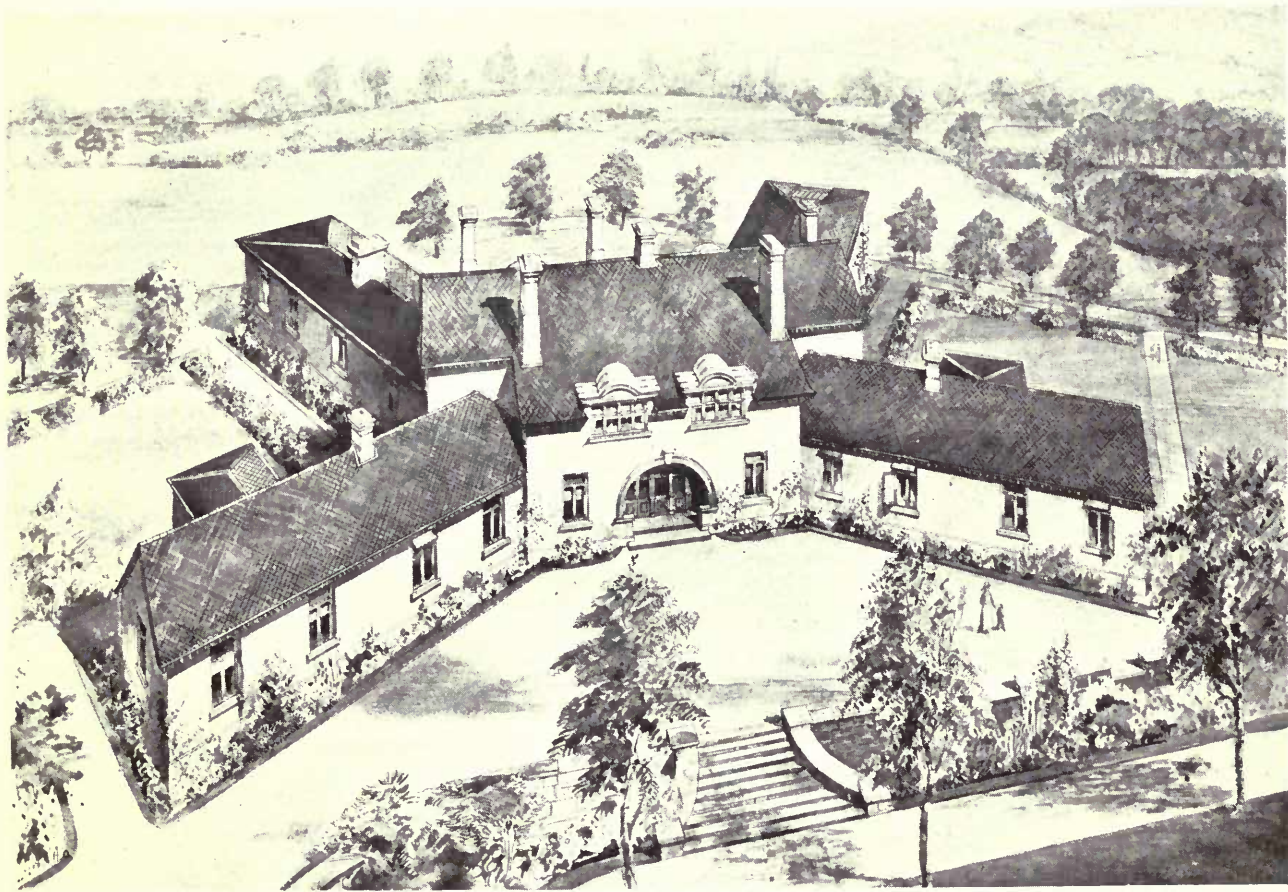

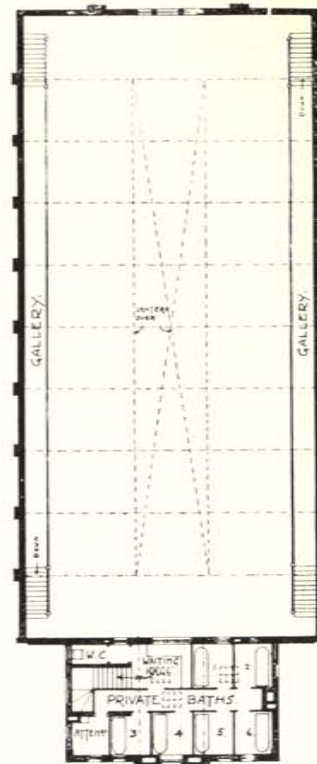

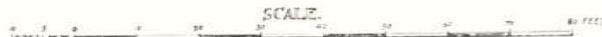
BASEMENT PLAN.

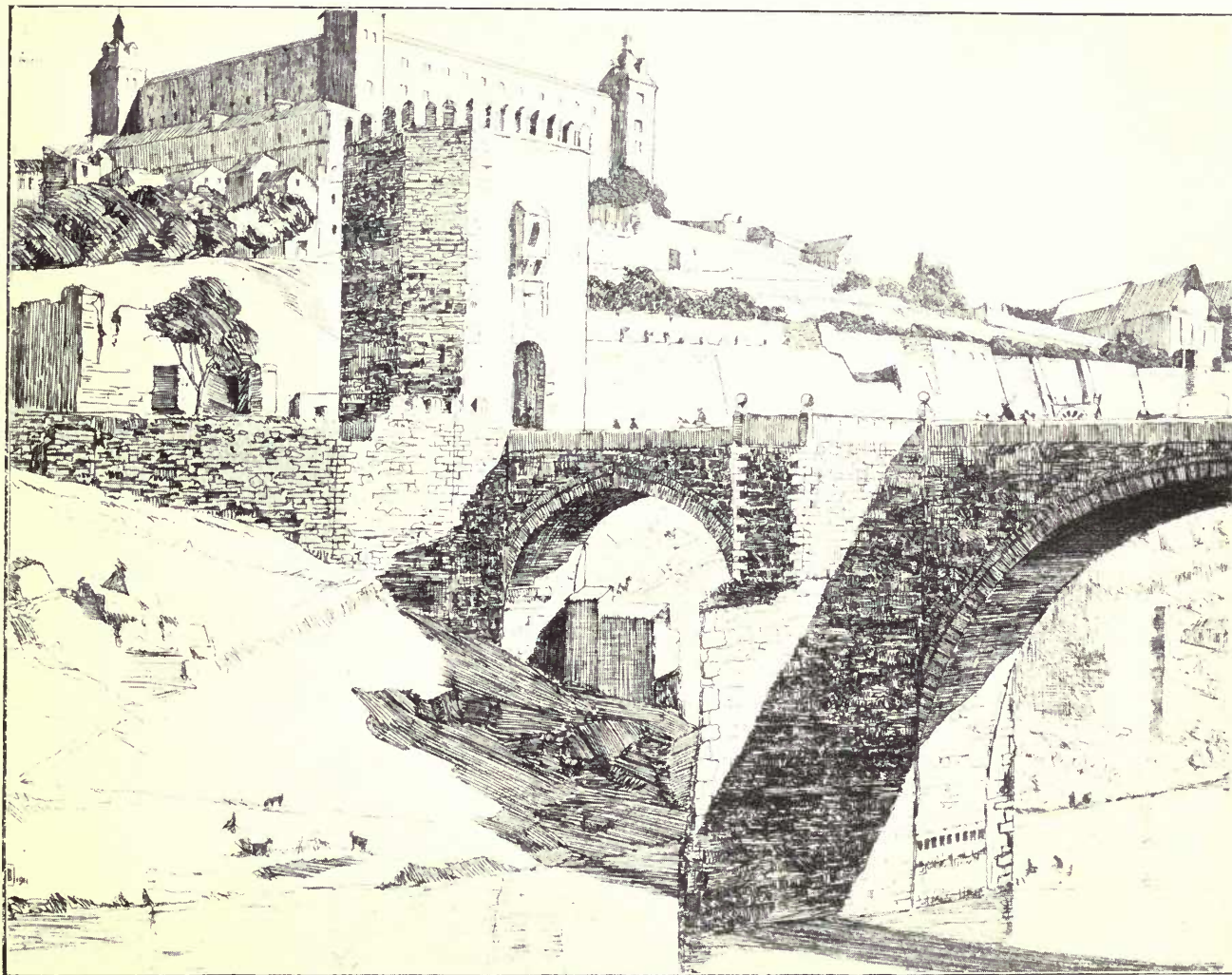

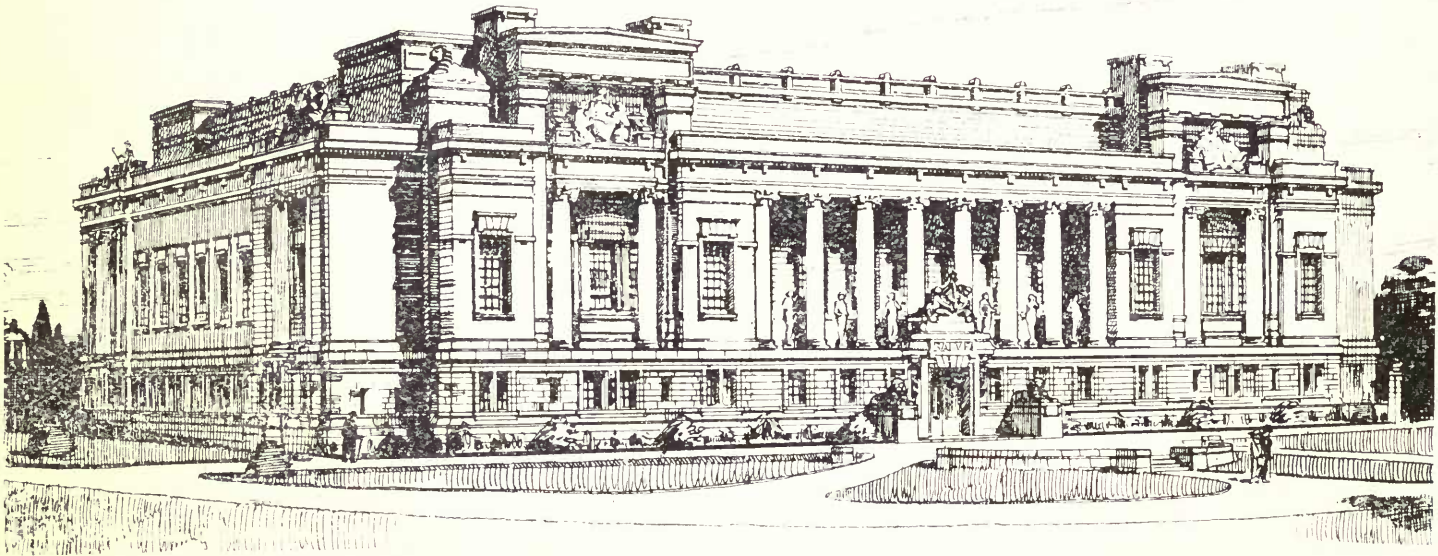

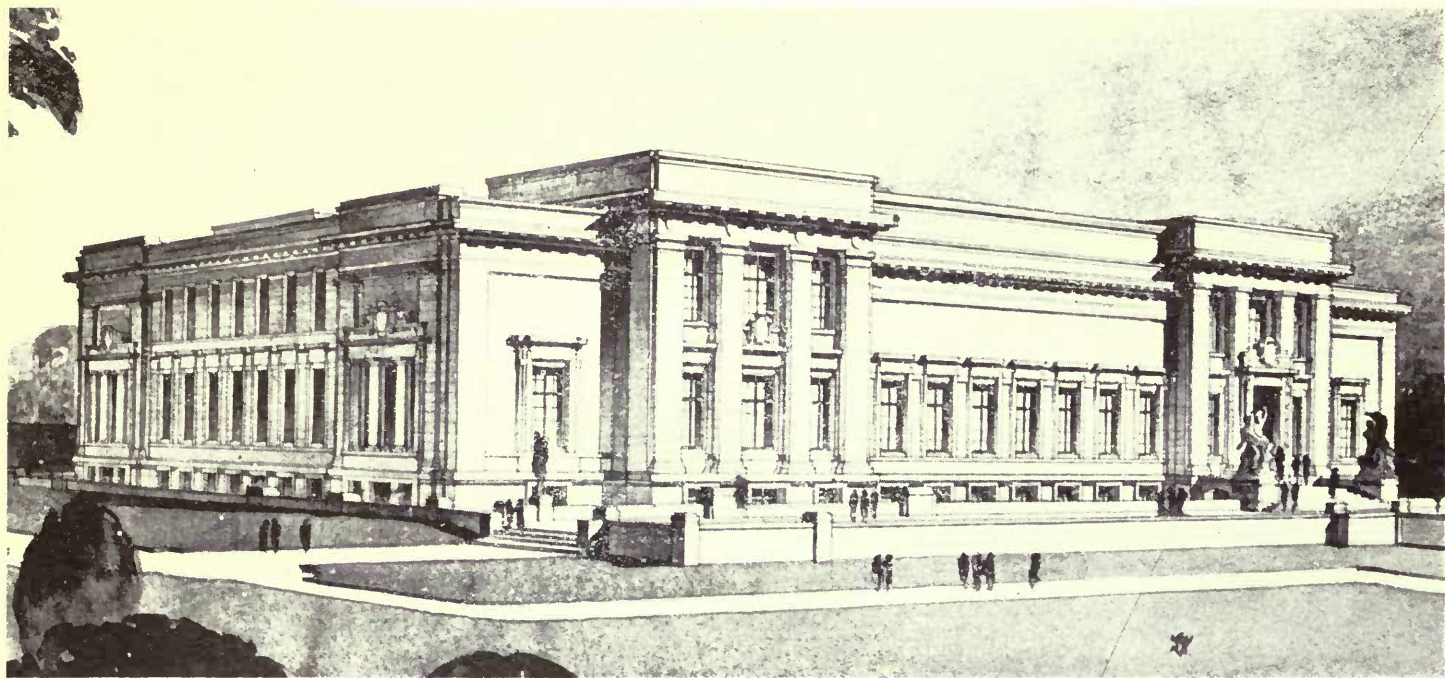

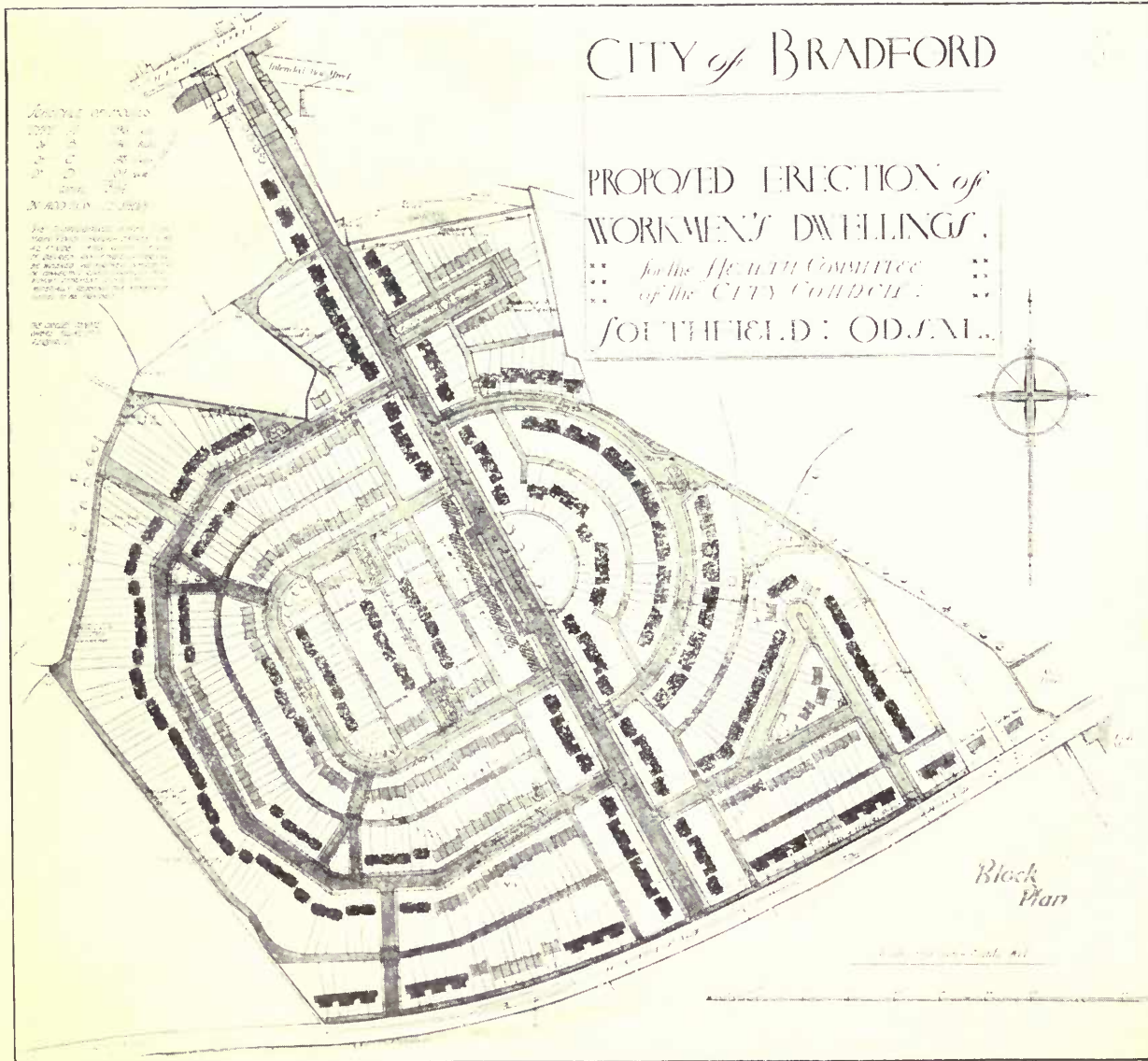

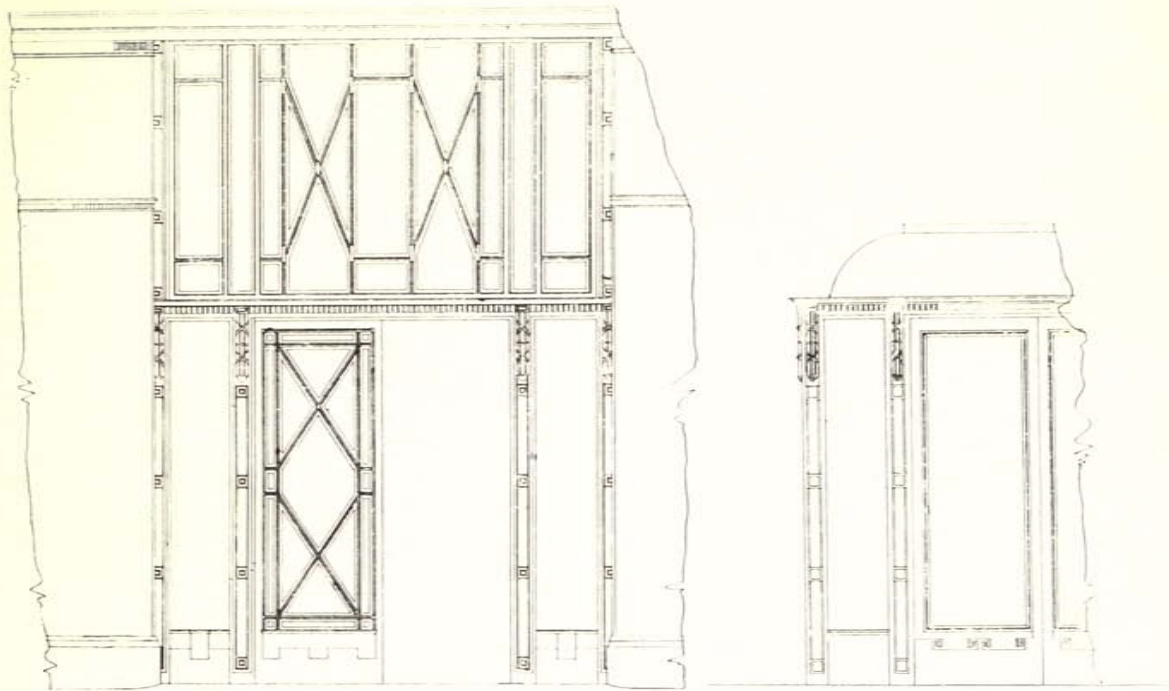

Elevation of Entrance Doors to Messrs. Lewis's, Manchester.

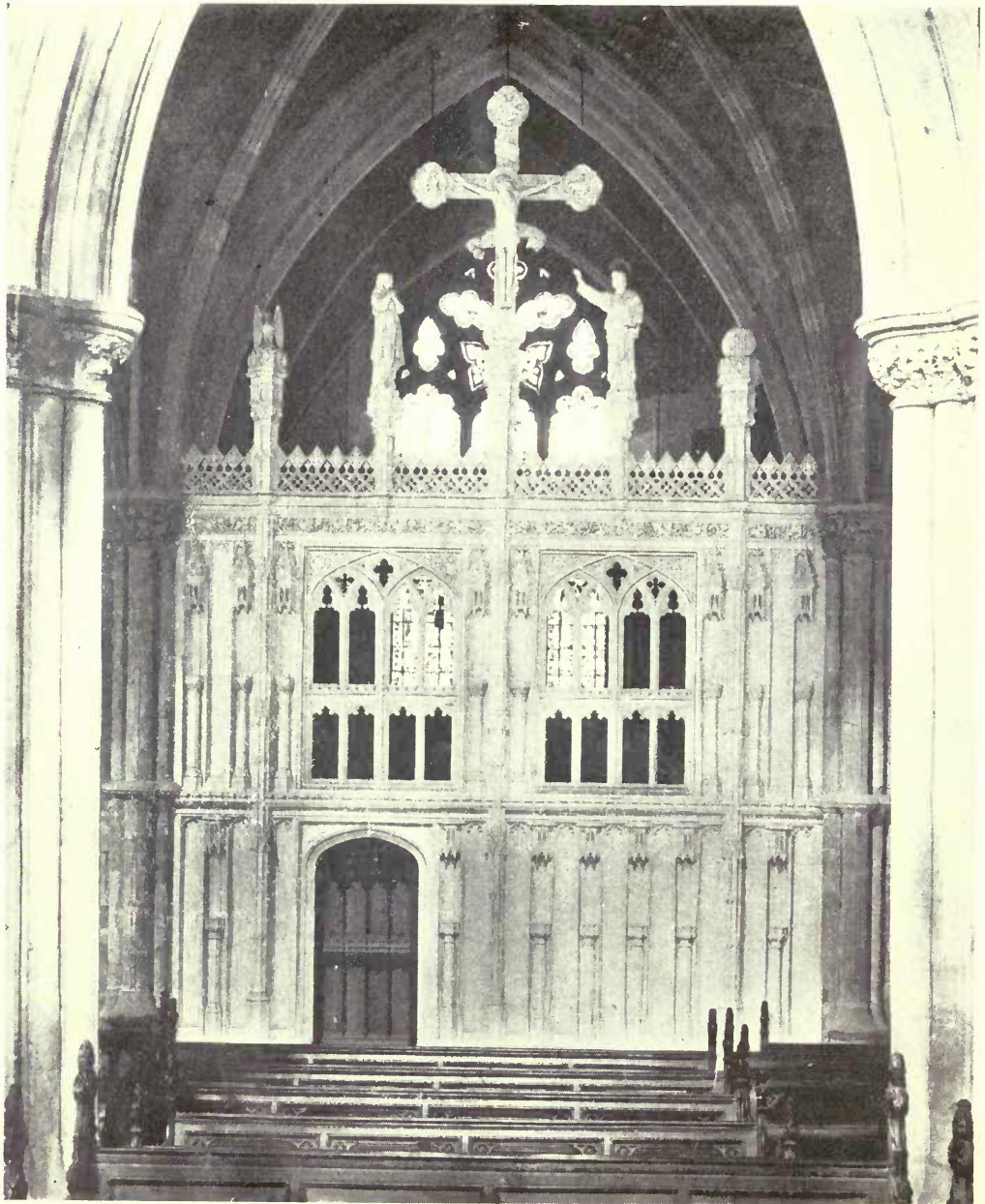

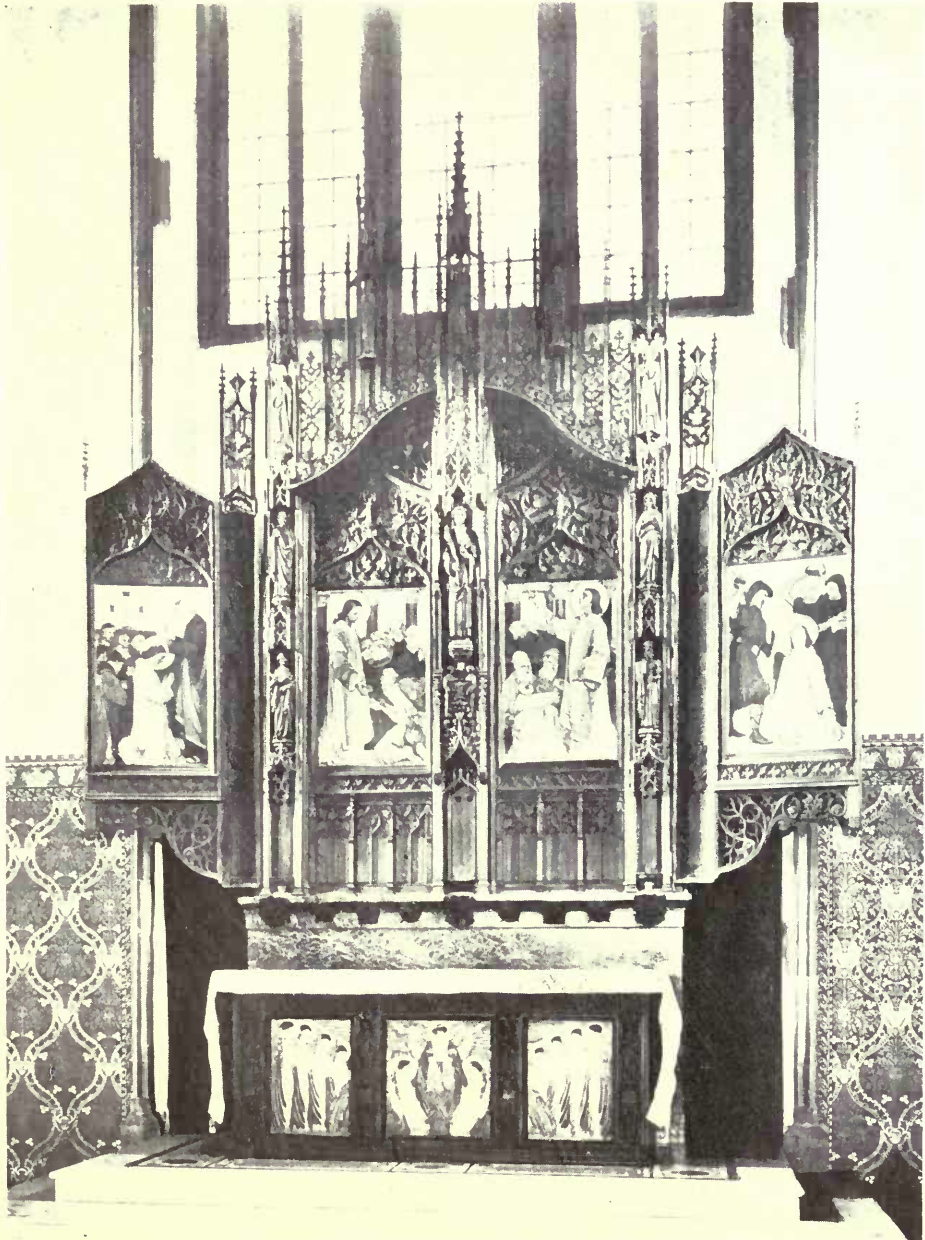

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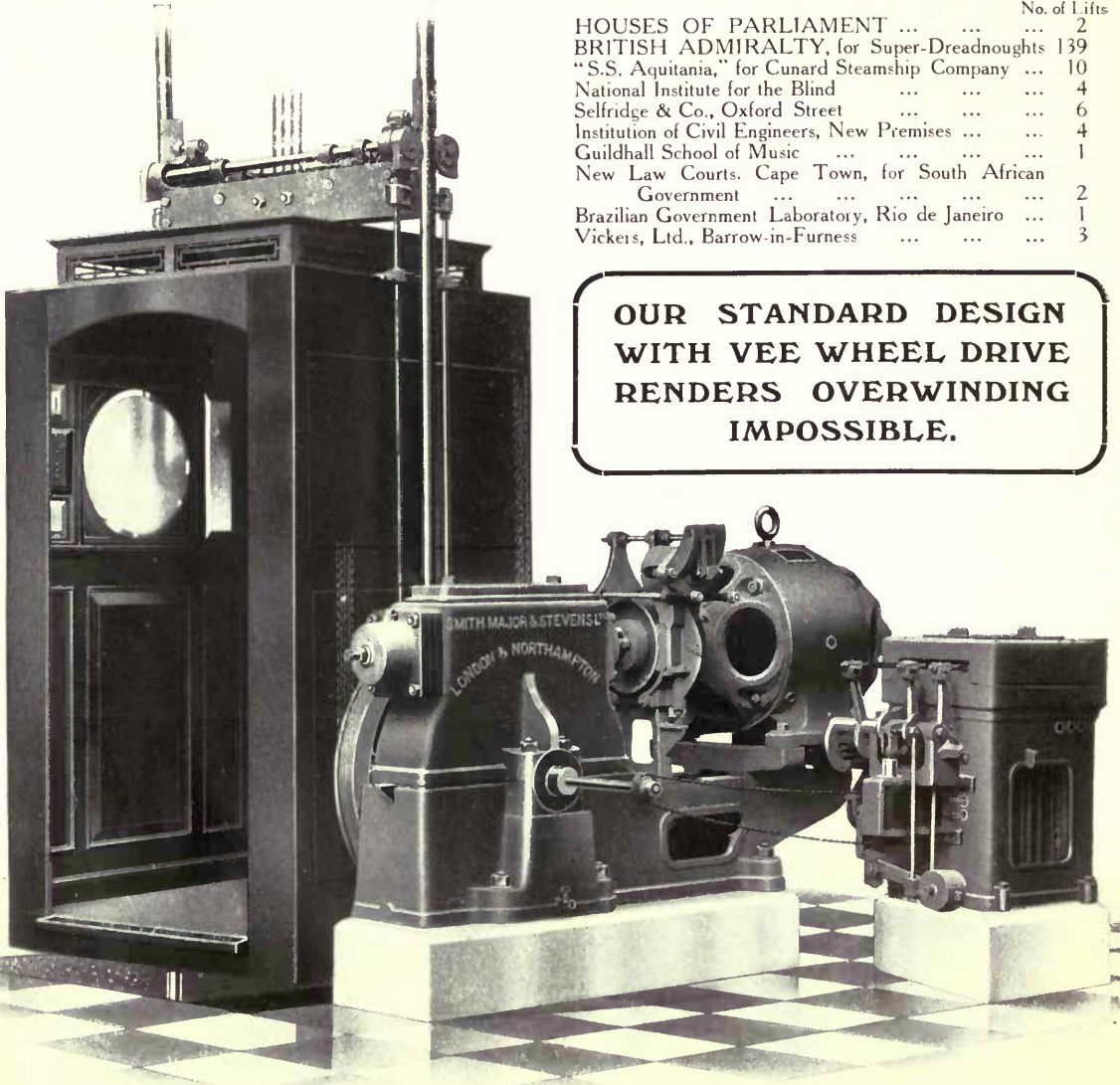
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
